## SHOW-N-SHINE JUDGING SHEET

- The judges are comparing cars against each other and not looking at cars as they would be straight out of the showroom.
- Cars will be judged for the workmanship, detailed tidiness and cleanliness.
- Please don't leave unnecessary items in your car, presentation is a must.
- Displaying your car with merchandise, pictures etc. is encouraged to make it a whole presentation of the vehicle on the day.
- Entrants may be asked to judge a class other than the one they are entered in.
- Original class will be judged on originality, tidiness, cleanliness and presentation

<p><b><u>EXTERIOR:</u></b> Remember some of these cars are driven daily. Please do not deduct points for paint chips, and normal fair wear &amp; tear, look more for detail to cleanliness and effort of presentation. . Pay attention for polish residue left behind, dirt on the paintwork, especially around the seams, gutters, and around hinges and handles, inspect paintwork from different angles for signs of streaking, scratches and swirl marks.</p>	<b>Points Out of <u>25</u></b>
<p><b><u>INTERIOR:</u></b> Detail here should be towards cleanliness and tidiness, clean carpets and mats, look for rubbish and dirt in door pockets, and unnecessary items and rubbish inside the car. Interior can have items that would have been there when the car was delivered from the Dealer, log books, delivery receipts, are OK. Display merchandise in and around the car is encouraged if neatly presented. Car boots, Ute trays and Van rears are judged as interior</p>	<b>Points Out of <u>25</u></b>
<p><b><u>UNDER CARRIAGE, WHEELS and TYRES:</u></b> Again remember some cars are driven daily and will show signs of normal use, dents and scratches, stone chips, etc. Attention should be towards cleanliness, attention to effort to remove oil, dirt, and road grime and brake dust.</p>	<b>Points Out of <u>25</u></b>
<p><b><u>ENGINE BAY:</u></b> Cleanliness, attention to detail, and effort in presentation are important and key factors to look out for. Look around the base of Master Cylinders for oil and dirt, check the back of the Rocker Cover, and generally look for effort in cleaning and presentation.</p>	<b>Points Out of <u>25</u></b>
