<u>BEFORE</u> applying for or renewing Historic Conditional registration with the MiniCar Club NSW

You must...

- 1) Be a current financial member of the Mini Car Club NSW. (membership expires 31 December each year)
- 2) Have a Safety Inspection (pink slip) carried out by an <u>Authorised person</u> and provide the report number on the CP01 and 1259 sheets.
- 3) Have the car inspected and signed off by an Eligibility examiner from the Mini Car Club.
- 4) Have current insurance (minimum 3rd Party/Property) and provide details on the CP01 form.
- 5) Fully complete the checklist (CP01) form, and sign at the bottom, including CURRENT vehicle insurance details.
- 6) Complete two (2) 1259 Historic Vehicle Declaration forms.
- 7) Send all 4 sheets (CP01, CP03 and duplicate 1259 forms **INCLUDING A STAMPED SELF ADDRESSED ENVELOPE** to the Historic Plate Registrar, who will stamp and return one 1259 form for you to take to the Services NSW office for registration renewal.

(Take the Safety Inspection Certificate (pink slip) and stamped and signed 1259 form to the Services NSW office for registration and/or renewal)

Failure to comply with the MCC and RMS Historic Plate rules may result in your ineligibility to remain on the scheme. It is a member's responsibility to comply, as not doing so may render you and the Mini Car Club NSW open to litigation should an accident occur and the MCC Historic registration be found to not be in accordance with the above requirements.
