Mini Car Club of NSW Nirimba State Championship Motorkhana – Round 7

1. AUTHORITY:

The Event will be conducted under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices, the National Competition Rules (NCR) of Motorsport Australia, the Motorkhana Standing Regulations, the NSW Motorkhana Addendum, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations or instructions which may be issued.

The Event will be conducted under and in accordance with Motorsport Australia OH&S, Safety 1st, Integrity and Legal, and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the Motorsport Australia website at www.motorsport.org.au. Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by Motorsport Australia in relation to the Event. Further details can be found in the Motorsport Australia Insurance Handbook, available at www.motorsport.org.au.

19.SCRUTINY:

A self-scrutiny vehicle check must be performed by the competitor and driver using the Motorsport Australia Self-Scrutiny Checklist – Auto Test. The Self-Scrutiny Checklist Form and the Event Entry Self-Scrutiny Statement of Vehicle Compliance declaration must be completed, signed scanned and emailed to the Event Secretary prior to the Event or, if this is not possible, provided at documentation on the morning of the Event. The Chief Scrutineer will conduct visual spot checks throughout the day.

Competition numbers will be allocated by the Organisers.

20.SCRUTINY – SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS

- a) All vehicles shall comply with the Technical Appendix Schedule A and Group 4H of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- b) **All Mini Mokes must be fitted with a roll over protection structure as per Group 4H of the Motorsport Australia Manual.**
- c) Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- d) All cars must be adequately muffled to comply with public road noise restrictions.
- e) All loose items must be removed. Battery must be well secured.
- f) All wheel nuts/studs must be present and secure.
- g) Approved helmets in accordance with Schedule D of the Motorsport Australia Manual are to be worn in ALL specials.
- h) Adequate footwear must be worn by all Drivers whilst competing, (bare feet, thongs or sandals are not permitted), and all apparel shall comply with Schedule D of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- i) Drivers of cars to which no windscreen is fitted must wear adequate eye protection whilst competing.
- j) All Drivers shall, whilst competing, wear a properly adjusted seat belt, as per Schedule I of the Motorsport Australia Manual.
- k) Any camera or video recording device mounted in or on a competition vehicle must be approved by the Chief Scrutineer.

Note: Electric vehicles (EVs) will not be permitted to be entered at this Event, due to lack of officials' specific training and EV-specific safety equipment.

21.LICENCES:

Competitors must hold a current and valid Speed/Speed Junior Competition Licence or superior. Competition licences, proof of membership of a Motorsport Australia affiliated car club and Log Books (if issued) must be produced at Document Check during registration.

22.CLASSES:

Motorkhana Classes:

- Class A Production Vehicles Wheelbase up to 2150mm
 - Class B Production Vehicles Wheelbase 2151 to 2390mm
 - Class C Production Vehicles Wheelbase 2391 to 2574mm
 - Class D Production Vehicles Wheelbase 2575mm and over.
 - Class E 4WD Vehicle (*which must be driven in four wheel drive throughout the event*)
 - Class F Front Wheel Drive Specials
 - Class G Rear Wheel Drive Specials
 - Class H Production Sedan Based Specials
- Non-production 4WS (4 wheel steering) and 4WD vehicles are not permitted)*
Note: Group 4H regulations prohibit 4WD in specials

Motorkhana Categories:

(Nomination in a category does not preclude a driver from competing for class awards)

- Category J Juniors
- Category LP Ladies in Production Vehicles
- Category LS Ladies in Specials

(Any of the following will be classified as "Specials" or as described in 4H of the Motorsport Australia Manual)

1. Non production vehicles
2. Vehicles which have, in the opinion of the Director, been significantly lightened
3. Vehicles fitted with "fiddle brakes"
4. Vehicles fitted with foot brakes which operates the rear wheels only
5. Vehicles with racing - type tyres or slick recapped tyres

NOTE: Competitors must nominate their classes prior to the start of competition.

Any class or category which attracts less than three entries may be amalgamated with other class/es at the discretion of the organisers.

23.RESULTS, PRIZES AND TROPHIES:

- 1st Outright
- 2nd Outright
- 3rd Outright
- 1st in each Class
- 1st in each Category
- Best Mini Car Club Competitor

NOTE: All awards are mutually exclusive.

Results will be determined by fastest time for each test

24.CONDUCT OF THE EVENT:

The Motorsport Australia permit will be displayed at the start of the event

Start and finish procedures shall be in accordance with the Motorkhana Standing Regulations

Running order shall be at the discretion of the clerk of course

Timing shall be to 0.01 of a second

All officials shall be deemed to be Judges of Fact in accordance with the Motorkhana Standing Regulations.

Failure to comply with any instruction given by an official of the Event may result in the competitor being excluded from the Event by the Clerk of the Course.

The Organiser reserves the right to postpone or stop the Event in accordance with the NCR.

Any Protests must be lodged in accordance with the provisions of the NCR.

25.PASSENGERS:

This Event will include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the Motorsport Australia MSPRA Policy.

As per the current Motorkhana Standing Regulations and the 2025 Motorsport Australia NSW Motorkhana Championship Addendum, passengers are allowed to accompany a driver as a trainee or an observer, there is no penalty for a driver that carries a passenger, and the Driver will be eligible to score points in the NSW Motorkhana Championship.

26.FACILITIES:

Toilet facilities are available in the “BREED” building across the road from the venue

Fuel is not available at the venue. The nearest service station is on the corner of Grady Street and Quakers Hill Parkway, a five minute drive from the venue.

27.DAMAGE TO EQUIPMENT:

The organisers reserve the right to recover the cost of any equipment damaged (including shipping charges) from anyone who damages equipment during the course of the event, whether this be deliberate or accidental

28.INTEGRITY:

Smoking (which includes e-cigarettes and “vaping”) and any naked flame is prohibited within 3 metres of any refuelling/defueling operation.

Motorsport Australia’s National Integrity Framework and any associated policy (including the Australian Anti-Doping Policy, Motorsport Australia’s Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy, the Motorsport Australia Alcohol Policy), apply to any activity authorised by Motorsport Australia as published at www.motorsport.org.au. Any Participant including the holder of a Motorsport Australia Licence (or a Licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of alcohol, any drug or other banned substance. In addition to any penalty imposed by Motorsport Australia, a further penalty/s may be applied by Sport Integrity Australia.

Consumption of alcohol in any Reserved Area is prohibited until all Competition is concluded each day.
