## **BEFORE** applying or renewing for Conditional/Modified registration through the Mini Car Club of NSW: YOU MUST:

- 1) Be a financial member of the Mini Car Club NSW. (provide membership card) (MEMBERSHIP EXPIRES 31 DECEMBER EACH YEAR)
- 1) Provide a Blue Slip to the MCC Plate Examiner and provide the number on the CPM02 and 1835 form. (*Pink slip for year 2 onwards unless further modified*)
- 2) Provide proof of Engineering approval for required modifications for viewing. (If further modifications are made to a vehicle the owner must notify the Club Plate Registrar.)
- 3) Have the car inspected and passed by a Mini Car Club Eligibility examiner.
- 4) Although it is not a requirement we recommend you have a miniumum of 3<sup>rd</sup> party/property insurance for your car.
- 5) Complete this eligibility checklist (CPM02) sheet.
- 6) Complete two (2) **1835 forms** Classic Vehicle Declaration (provided with your renewal from the Transport for NSW or download from the MCC website)
- 7) Complete two (2) CMC "Check list of requirements of the Classic Vehicle Scheme (CVS)" (Form can be downloaded from CMC web site)
- 8) Send all 6 sheets (CPM02, CP03, 2 x 1835 forms and 2 x "Check list of requirements of the Classic Vehicle Scheme (CVS)" INCLUDING A STAMPED SELF ADDRESSED ENVELOPE to the MCC Club Plate Registrar, who will stamp and return one of the 1835 forms and "Check list of requirements of the Classic Vehicle Scheme (CVS)" for you to provide to the CMC CVS for their approval.
- 9) It is recommended you contact either Rob or Warwick via phone or email prior to posting your documents to ensure they are not away.
- 10) Send the completed and stamped 1835 form and "Check list of requirements of the Classic Vehicle Scheme (CVS)" to the CMC CVS for stamping and approval. Note: If both documents are not provided then Registration will be refused by CMC CVS.

(take the Safety Inspection Certificate (blue slip for 1st year) (pink slip) and stamped and signed 1835 form to the Services NSW office for initial registration or renewal)

Failure to comply with these Club Plate rules may result in your ineligibility to be on the scheme.

It is your responsibility to comply, as not doing so may render you and the Mini Car Club liable to litigation should an accident occur and the MCC Club Plate registration be found to not be in accordance with the above requirements.
